- 2. Abstract: Clearly outlining the intent of the thesis
- 3. **Keywords:** Provide at least 5 keywords
- 4. Research Contributions: Please list at least 3 major research findings from the thesis
- 5. Brief Explanation of Research Outcomes: A note on individual research contributions
- 6. **Research Dissemination:** The research papers/tools published out of and strictly restricted to the thesis. Citing research papers unrelated to the thesis may lead to rejection of the Ph.D. forum report.

Domain of the Ph.D. Thesis: Aligned with any track in the conference. Please note that the thesis need not be exactly limited by the tracks listed.

Author Details: Qualification, experience, other conference presentations or publications in similar domains showcasing speaker's expertise. Please provide a biography of each speaker (limiting to 300 words each).
